

Request of Government

We are seeking \$5 million in funding from the State Government for 5-ways intersection safety improvements.

The problem

- Our community continues to raise concerns regarding the safety of the intersection at Ringwood-Warrandyte Road, Croydon Road, Husseys Lane and Brumbys Lane in Warrandyte South (commonly known as '5-ways').
- Over the last few years, there has been higher than average casualty crashes, including a number of fatalities, and countless incidents involving collisions with local wildlife.
- The safety risk and fatality concerns are expected to increase, with the volume of visitors and road users predicted to reach 15,000 vehicles per day by 2035.
- The 5-ways intersection in Warrandyte South was the highest rated intersection identified for safety concerns in the Manningham local government area in the 2023 RACV inaugural My Melbourne Road survey.
- We have been advocating to the State Government and directly to the Department of Transport and Planning (DTP) for multiple years seeking help to fix this serious safety issue.



The solution

- Funding for the upgrade of these roads is the responsibility of the State Government.
- It is beyond Council's resources to allocate the significant funds that would be required to upgrade this intersection.
- Whilst this is a State Government owned road, Manningham Council has taken the initiative to prepare a concept layout, proposing to install a roundabout at the intersection.
- This layout is to assist Department of Transport and Planning in their consideration of selecting 5-ways as one of its priority projects within its road improvement program.
