

5-ways intersection

safety improvements

Request of Government

We are seeking \$5 million in funding from the Federal and State Governments for 5-ways intersection safety improvements.

The problem

- Our community continues to raise concerns about the safety of the intersection at Ringwood-Warrandyte Road, Croydon Road, Husseys Lane and Brumbys Lane in Warrandyte South (commonly known as '5-ways').
- In recent years, the intersection has seen several near misses and accidents, including one serious injury crash.
- With Ringwood Warrandyte Road and Croydon Road carrying a combined 19,600 vehicles a day, the safety risks are expected to continue.
- The 5-ways intersection in Warrandyte South was the highest rated intersection identified for safety concerns in the Manningham local government area in the 2023 RACV inaugural My Melbourne Road survey.
- We have been advocating to the State Government and directly to the Department of Transport and Planning (DTP) for multiple years seeking help to fix this serious safety issue.



The solution

- Funding for the upgrade of this intersection is the responsibility of the State Government.
- It is beyond Council's resources to allocate the significant funds that would be required to deliver the upgrade.
- These roads are owned by the State Government, however Manningham Council has taken initiative to assist the Department of Transport and Planning to develop options to improve the intersection by providing traffic survey and safety audit data.
