## We're making improvements to Hanke Reserve

### Where we'll be working

- Hanke Reserve and 17 Hanke Road, Doncaster.

### What we're doing

- Removing side fence between 17 Hanke Road and Hanke Reserve.
- Demolishing dwelling at 17 Hanke Road (including asbestos removal).
- Landscaping the expanded park area. This includes new tree planting, access path, furniture, and drinking fountain.

### When to expect us

- We plan to begin works early June and finish by end of June 2025.
- Workers will be on site between 7.00am and 5.00pm on weekdays.
- This schedule is subject to weather conditions.
